

## IntelliCom Security Bulletin - ISFR-4404-0010- Information

### Possibility to read system files using HTTP

#### Platform/Product:

Netbiter products based on the NB100 and NB200 platforms, including WS100, WS200.

#### Summary

A user that has been authenticated with the level “superadmin” (highest authentication level) has permission to read system files by calling read.cgi with options to read a system file. Users with “superadmin” privileges also have the possibility to use directory traversal to find these system files in the file system structure.

#### Recommendation / Solution

IntelliCom has released a security patch for the WS100 and WS200 products that limits the possibility to read system files and also removes the possibility to do directory traversal. We recommend users of the WS100/WS200 products to download the patch “ISFR-4404-0010.npb” from <http://support.intellicom.se> and apply it. Since the default user in Netbiter products has “superadmin” privileges, we strongly recommend customers to change the default password immediately when commissioning the product. In addition we strongly advise customers to provide only the necessary privileges to non-administrator users of the product.
